**As parents, coaches, and volunteers, we all have expectations of one another that we must respect.** Here are some expectations of parents and coaches set by the Roseville Broncos organization and, our league, the OMYFA:

Coaches/GM's	Parents/Spectators
Provide a safe environment for players to learn and grow through the sport.	View/experience games and practices without entering the field.
Communicate with/Answer questions of players and parents honestly and effectively.	Respect the decisions of our trainer with regards to injury.
Promote fair play and positive sportsmanship in all practice/game situations.	If you have questions on a coach's decision or are upset, please wait 24 hours before approaching the head coach privately to discuss.
Promote player growth and improvement throughout the season through challenging, but constructive practices.	Provide a positive influence from the stands through cheering for the team without demeaning the opponent.



**It is imperative that all parents stay off the practice and game fields.** We encourage all parents to watch practices at RJS, but a parent’s presence on the practice field undermines the coach’s authority; if a parent enters the practice field, they will be asked to leave. A good rule of thumb is to stay outside of the field fences at the RJS facility. **Also, it is a league rule that all parents stay off the field at all games: even in case of injury.** We have a highly qualified athletic trainer, Jules Parker, who works with a number of high school teams; she will assess all on field injuries and will notify parents if their presence is required.

**Positive sportsmanship is expected from all of our Bronco community members: GM’s, Coaches, Parents, Players, Spectators, Volunteers, etc.** We need to provide the example to our players and be “good sports” even in the face of adversity.

**A few housekeeping items:**

- Game socks will be sold at the concessions stand for \$5.00 during most practices prior to the first game. You can purchase these whenever the concessions window is open.
- We will have a scrimmage on Saturday August 22. The scrimmage will start at 9:00 AM. More information will be available soon.
